Recommendations Regarding Freedom of Religion with
Special Emphasis on Compliance of Greece with the ECtHR
Judgments

In light of the recent case law of the European Court of Human Rights, the NCHR proposed the modification, according to the abovementioned jurisprudence, of the current Greek legal framework regarding:

- 1. Prosecution of proselytism. The Greek State was urged to proceed with the abrogation of the relevant legislation in force and create a new legal framework grounded on the right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion;
- 2. The establishment of places of worship. The NCHR urged the Greek authorities to abrogate the relevant obsolete legislation and comply with the judgments of the European Court of Human Rights;
- 3. The situation of the Muslim minority in western Thrace. The NCHR pointed out that the competence of Muftis in Thrace should be limited to religious affairs only and not transcend to the fields of administration and justice;
- 4. Discrimination against conscientious objectors. The NCHR proposed the modification of Greek legislation with a view to eliminating legal and social discrimination against conscientious objectors to military service.
